From Your Chair: A new Chair for the Precinct could not be elected at the October meeting because the quorum of 12 attendees was not met. The Precinct will be electing a new Chair at the November 3rd meeting. All residents are encouraged to attend the precinct meetings – Be informed of events, works and upcoming projects that affect Fairy Bower Precinct!

Summary of October's Precinct Meeting

Because it can be difficult to secure the MLCSC as a venue for precinct meetings, a motion has been proposed to hold all future meetings at the Manly Community Centre on Wentworth St.

Other business discussed at the meeting included a request for repairs to the steps leading from Bower St. to Manly Beach. Council has already undertaken this project and the repairs are near completion.

Unfortunately the upgrades and repairs to the Fairy Bower Pool are not being addressed as quickly. The pool has been confirmed safe and

can be used, however needed repairs and the installation of a steel platform for staff to open and close the water valve have yet to be scheduled.

The Precinct has also been informed by council that there are no plans to install additional seating at Shelly Beach. It was requested that this item be revisited at a later date and perhaps amend the request to install memorial seats.

A number of Development Applications were also discussed. Details of these can be found in the minutes of the meeting, which are available upon request.
