Precinct Budget Bids

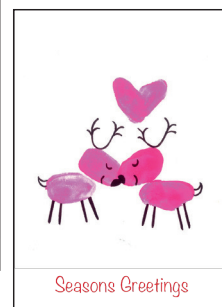
Our Precinct Budget bids for 2015-2016 have all been successful.

MAIN COUNCIL RESPONSES

Shelly Beach

Re-turfing, seating installation and sand drift project have been completed for summer season. Showers at beach should have been in early October.

Stairs from carpark to Shelly Beach

The entry stairs have been replaced. The secondary set of stairs from top end car park to lower entry road will be considered for work in next financial year.

Spikes on lamp posts at Fairy Bower Pool

Council had decided not to re-install bird-repelling spikes. The Precinct questioned this decision as spikes have worked well in the past. The council has now agreed to consider installing them.

3-11 Cliff St - Grass Verge

The council is investigating putting a path and grass verge at that end of Cliff St.

Designated Swim Zone at Cabbage Tree Bay

The swim zone is now in place. It is a rectangle stretching 60m out from the Shelly Beach shoreline. It's there for a 12 months' trial, which started on Oct 1. Power boats are banned from this area. The exclusive swim zone will be advertised on signs on land as well as signs on buoys which will be moored along the zone border. Although the swim zone area is very small, hopefully this is the start of something bigger.

Royal Far West (Elsie Hill) Update

The project to build a new Centre for Child Health and Learning on the site of the existing Elsie Hill Building in Wentworth St is in the detailed design stage. Documents will be available for tendering soon.

Manly Cinema Update

The cinema on East Esplanade, which has been closed for months, is likely to be stripped out and the site sold as vacant space, as that is how it would be most valuable. Sad as this is, the council has no influence on the matter.

Fairy Bower Pool

The precinct is frustrated that even though the pool surface, both underwater and around the edges, is rough, broken up and jagged, Manly Council keeps insisting it's "fit for purpose". It should be resurfaced which would make it safer for people using it and easier to clean.

The precinct will ask for an inspection to be undertaken with council staff when the pool is emptied for cleaning.

FAIRY BOWER POOL SCULPTURES

You all probably noticed that the beautiful sculptures have been restored after a few months of turning white, patched up then a vibrant blue undercoat and now the final bronze finish. Council engaged the original sculptor Helen Leete to complete the restoration. A great result all round.

To refresh your memories here is a little bit of history.

Oceanides by Helen Leete, 1997

Sited on the edge of the ocean rock pool at Fairy Bower is the popular sculpture by Helen Leete, called **Oceanides**.

Oceanides refers to the sea nymphs of Greek mythology which were often part human and part sea-creature. They reflect the exuberant energy and playfulness that the Greek philosophers called 'the laughter of the gods'. The two figures represent joyful bathers in the sun and sea, luxuriating in the beauty of Manly and the relationship between humankind and other creatures. Donated to Manly Council by Rosemary Eather, 2004. Helen Leete also has sculptures in The Royal Botanic Gardens, Sydney, Macquarie University Sculpture Park, Kuringai Art Centre and Gallery 460 Sculpture Park, Gosford.

This sculpture is one of around 20 public artworks and monuments in Manly. The 'Public Sculpture in Manly Project' was established in 1997 and reflects the continued commitment of Manly Council to the cultural development of this area and our community.

WHALE WATCHING

Whale Watching Season runs from mid May through to mid November. Just because your not a tourist does not mean you can't get out there and enjoy these spectacular creatures.

Manly is the ideal venue to join a whale watching tour, as over 3000 whales migrate past, and even into, Sydney Harbour every year. This allows for a very high whale spotting percentage every trip.

Right here in Manly there are tour operators that offer tours out past the stunning 300ft vertical cliffs of Sydney Heads into the Pacific Ocean in search of magnificent Humpback and Southern Right whales.

Late morning and early afternoon are reasonably good times of the day to whale watch as the glare off the water doesn't make sighting the tell-tale 'blow' too tricky. Early morning can also be a good time as the 'blow' is often highlighted by the back light of the morning sun.

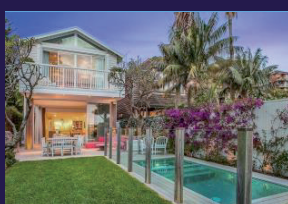

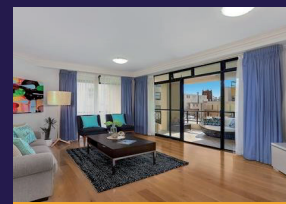
