

SHELLY THE TURTLE

Affectionately nicknamed Shelly, the Green Sea turtle was rescued from Cabbage Tree Bay in January this year looking a little worse for wear. She was brought back to health by the team at Manly SEA LIFE Sanctuary before being fitted with a satellite tag, made possible by donations from the public including The Bold and The Beautiful. SEA LIFE Trust has contributed over \$4,000 to Shelly's tag and the satellite costs.

If you want to follow Shelly's adventures around the bay she can be tracked on www.turtlewatch.org.au. Her GPS tracker will retrieve data for about 12 months and provides important information on turtle behaviour.

MAIN COUNCIL RESPONSES

Marine Parade and Shelly Beach:

Council has convened a meeting in September with the service authorities to inform and engage them prior to commencing planning of Marine Parade Master Plan.

Precinct Comment: The works undertaken by Council in front of the Boathouse look great as do the new steps. Hopefully the other stairs to the car park can be similarly improved and the area around the new fire hydrant on Bower St revegetated.

Spikes on lamp-posts at Fairy Bower Pool

Council has investigated and will not be installing spikes.

Precinct Comment: Could council explain why spikes won't be installed as they worked well previously?

Lighting Bower Street Steps

Following correspondence from a resident highlighting issues associated with lighting of the stairs which include increased foot traffic, noise and parking issues and the effect on wildlife with the reserve it was decided that lighting of the steps should not proceed.

Fairy Bower Ocean Pool

Council fully drains the Fairy Bower Swimming Pool every fortnight, cleans the base and walls. During each cleaning process the pool is checked and assessed. The pool and surrounds are deemed to be in a suitable and satisfactory condition and there are no intentions to carry out any works at this point in time.

Precinct Response: Hopefully the state of the pool will be included in the Masterplan. Anyone who has cut their feet in the pool is urged to lodge a complaint to Council.

MANLY SEALIFE SANCTUARY

Thank you for the invitation to attend the Manly Precinct meeting on the 2nd of September.

Manly Sea Life Sanctuary (formally known as Marine land & Oceanworld) has been established since the 1960's. In addition to providing an opportunity for guests to view, and even dive with the amazing underwater local marine life displayed at the Sanctuary, we also operate as a licenced rescue and rehabilitation centre for injured marine wildlife. Recently



there has been a transition away from being simply an aquarium designed for public viewing, and an evolution towards focusing efforts on the rescue, rehabilitation and release of marine animals through our highly successful Breed, Rescue, and Protect program. Our rescues have included the removal of hooks and ropes from sharks, release of stranded stingrays, rehabilitation and release of sea turtles & sea snakes, as well as the initial triage on penguins. We are also developing captive breeding programs for a number of animals already homed within the Sanctuary in an effort to support the industry in becoming self-sustaining, and working in partnership with universities to support learning and industry progression. Manly SeaLife Sanctuary facilitates initiatives such as our Manly Cove beach clean-up on the first Friday of every month at 8am open to community participation, and provides informative talks to the public and school groups.
